We have most of the set up we need to do Free Bike Washes near biker events.

We have two 20' canopies so we can have three wash bays and three dry bays. Each wash bay has its own hose and sprayer and each dry bay has an overhead plug for an electric weed blower (*the blowers make it take a lot less towels to complete the job*). The North Texas district has loaned us a generator so we can set up and only need water provided.

We have signs leading up to the wash that say, "Free Bike Wash", "No Donations Accepted", "No Kidding", etc. We have one banner for the end of the wash and are waiting on a second one to be provided. The only thing we really need is three electric weed blowers and additional boxes of terry cloth towels.

We are also planning on gearing up to use these canopies for rest stops providing free coffee and free water. For those the set up needs will be a little different. Before we do this we will want banners that read "Free Coffee", "Free Water" and "Chaplain on Duty" as well as an insulated catering type container for keeping coffee warm and large ice chest for water.
